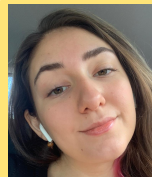

looking for food

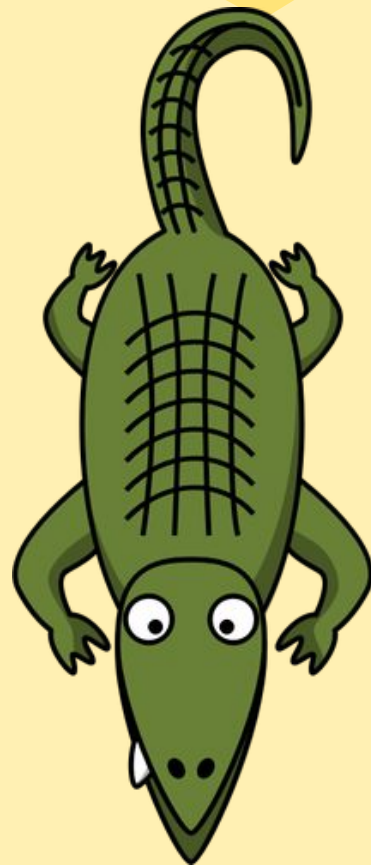
He had grown so much

he is looking good

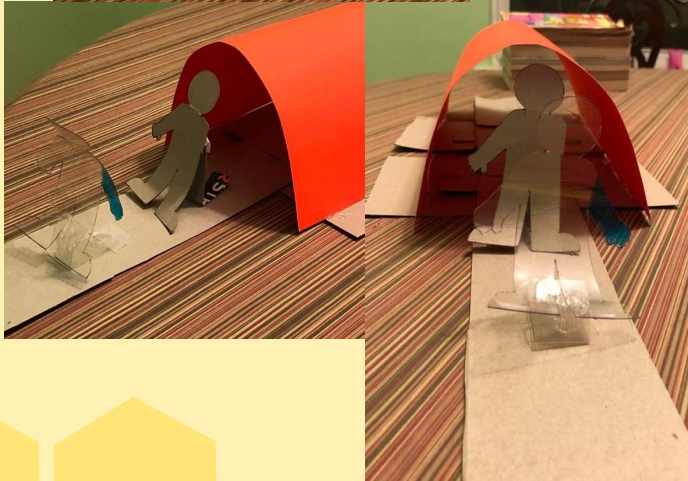
He had grown so much more and he

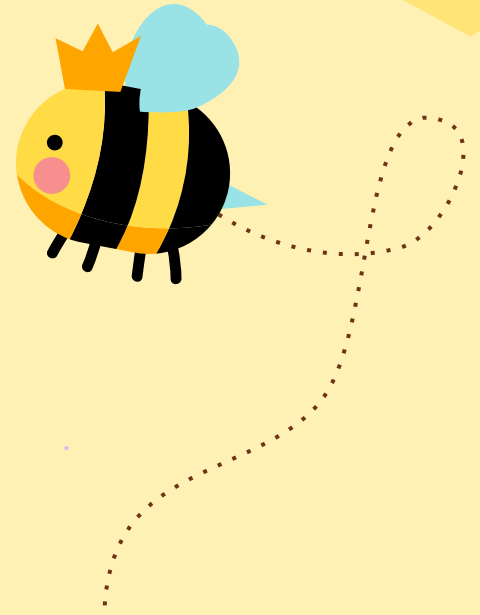
